



Oklahoma Medical Loan Repayment Program



The Oklahoma Medical Loan Repayment Program is a partnership between TSET and the Physicians Manpower Training Commission to recruit primary care physicians to medically underserved areas. Practicing physicians receive assistance repaying their medical school loans, if they practice medicine in these underserved areas. Physicians can receive up to \$160,000 if they complete four years of service in the program. Physicians must agree to serve a minimum of two years. Financial assistance is based on length of service.
